

Nevada Unemployment Information

Waiting Period	There is a 7-day waiting period before payments are made.
Job Search Requirements	Job Search Requirements are in place.
Recertification Frequency	Recertification needs to be completed every week.
Weekly Benefit (WBA) Calculation	If you are eligible to receive unemployment, your weekly benefit rate (WBR) will be 4% of your total earnings during the highest paid quarter of the base period, subject to a minimum of \$16 per week and a maximum of \$407 per week (as of July 1, 2014).
Maximum Weekly Benefit	The current maximum WBA is \$407.
Maximum # of Payments	Maximum benefit is 1/3 of total base period and no more than 26x the weekly benefit.

Ways to apply for benefits	<p>The preferred way to apply is online, using the link above. When to apply	File the first day you are unemployed. Your claim begins the Sunday of the week you first file a claim.
Information needed to apply	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Social Security Number • Residential Address • Phone Number • Employer Information
Child support and unemployment benefits	Income withholding is initiated when immediate income withholding is in effect or the NCP becomes delinquent in an amount equivalent to one (1) month's support. The claimant must have a UIB weekly benefit amount of at least \$50 before an intercept is initiated. The Nevada Revised Statutes allow for deductions up to sixty (60%) percent of the responsible parent's disposable earnings. However, the Nevada Child Support Enforcement Program will apply a limitation of fifty (50%) percent of the unemployment benefit unless the initiating agency certifies the facts necessary to justify the higher percentages.
